1 officer of the club, organization or corporation on whose behalf the application is made. The application shall be 2 3 accompanied by a fee as established by the board in accordance 4 with W.S. 33-1-201. The application shall show that the club, 5 organization or corporation has been in existence not less than thirty (30) days. Before any license is issued under 6 7 chapter to any person, club, organization or this 8 corporation, the applicant shall file with the state 9 treasurer a bond in an amount established by the board, not 10 to exceed the greater of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or the total estimated expenses associated with the match, with 11 12 good and sufficient surety, conditioned for the faithful 13 performance of the conditions of this chapter. The applicant shall provide an estimate of the expenses for the match based 14 15 on matches held at venues with similar audience capacity and 16 other relevant factors. The board shall verify that the application contains a good faith estimate of anticipated 17 18 expenses for the match. 19 20 33-48-110. 1 representatives designated as inspectors and deputy 2 inspectors for each county the state. Each inspector and 3 deputy shall receive from the board a card authorizing him to 4 act as an inspector wherever the board may designate him to 5 act. Any board member, may, and at least one (1) inspector or deputy shall, may be present at all matches conducted for 6 pecuniary profit and see that the rules and regulations of 7 8 the board are strictly observed. An inspector or deputy shall 9 may also be present at the counting of the gross receipts 10 and, if present, shall immediately mail without undue delay 11 provide to the board the written report received by the 12 inspector or deputy from the individual promoter or officer of the club, organization or corporation showing the number 13 of tickets sold, the gross amount of proceeds and other 14 matters as the board may prescribe. The board may establish 15 16 compensation for, and pay, any inspectors or deputies 17 appointed under this section from fees deposited in the mixed martial arts board account in accordance with W.S. 33-1-202 18 19 and this chapter.
