A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state elected officials; increasing the
2 salaries for state elected officials; providing for current
3 salaries; specifying applicability; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-101(a)(i) through (v) is amended to
9 read:

10

11 **9-3-101. Salaries; amount; date of payment.**

12

13 (a) Salaries for clerk of the supreme court and
14 district court reporters shall be determined by the supreme
15 court as authorized by legislative appropriations. Subject to

1 constitutional limitations the following state officers and
2 members of the judiciary shall receive the salaries indicated
3 by the figures following their respective titles:

5 (i) Governor~~\$105,000.00~~ \$112,000.00;

7 (ii) Secretary of state ...~~\$92,000.00~~ \$97,000.00;

9 (iii) State auditor~~\$92,000.00~~ \$97,000.00;

11 (iv) State treasurer~~\$92,000.00~~ \$97,000.00;

13 (v) Superintendent of public instruction~~\$92,000.00~~ \$97,000.

15 **Section 2.**

17 (a) Until such time as the salaries provided by Section
18 1 of this act become effective, state officers shall receive
19 the salaries indicated by the figure following their
20 respective titles:

22 (i) Governor\$105,000.00;

1 (ii) Secretary of state\$92,000.00;

3 (iii) State auditor\$92,000.00;

5 (iv) State treasurer\$92,000.00;

7 (v) Superintendent of public instruction\$92,000.00.

9 **Section 3.** Section 1 of this act shall apply to the
10 specified elected officials beginning with the term of office
11 commencing in 2023.

13 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2019.
