- 14 (a) Except as provided in subsection (cc), the
- 15 following are subject to forfeiture:

1 2 (b) Except as provided in subsection (cc), property 3 subject to forfeiture under this act may be seized by any law 4 enforcement officer of the state upon process issued by any 5 district court or district court commissioner having 6 jurisdiction over the property. Seizure without process may 7 be made if: 8 9 (cc) The following limitations to the seizure and 10 forfeiture of property under this section shall apply: 11 12 (i) A homestead, to the extent provided by W.S. 1-20-101 through 1-20-104, is exempt from seizure and 13 14 forfeiture; 15 (ii) A motor vehicle with a market value of less 16 17 than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) is exempt from seizure and forfeiture; 18 19 20 (iii) United States currency is exempt from 21 seizure and forfeiture if the total amount is one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or less; 22

(iv) The mere presence or possession of money,

securities or other negotiable instruments, without other

indicia of a violation of this act is insufficient probable

cause for seizure.
