1 (a) As used in this article: 2 3 4 (i) "Public entity" means the state, including the 5 executive, legislative and judicial branches of government and any department thereof, or any county, city, town, school 6 7 district, community college district, the University of 8 Wyoming or other public corporation of the state; 9 10 (ii) "Services" means the furnishing of labor, time or effort by a person to a public entity, including 11 12 professional services as defined in W.S. 9-2-1028(a)(v). The term does not include employment agreements; 13 14 15 (iii) "Supplies" means defined as in W.S. 16 9-2-1016(a)(iii). 17 18 16-6-1102. Disclosure for public contracts. 19 20 (a) A public entity shall require any person submitting 21 a bid or negotiating a contract for services or supplies to disclose to the public entity its five (5) most recently 22 completed or ongoing contracts of a similar type, which shall 23

1 include a description of supplies or services provided under

2 each contract and the total amount of compensation received

3 for each contract. A person that has not completed five (5)

4 contracts of a similar type shall disclose to the public

5 entity any completed or ongoing contracts of a similar type

6 as provided in this subsection. To the extent the disclosure

7 is not confidential under any federal or state law, the

8 disclosure shall be a public record and shall be open for

9 inspection after the bid or contract has been awarded.

11 (b) Disclosure under subsection (a) of this section

12 shall not be required if the public entity determines

13 disclosure by the person submitting a bid or negotiating a

14 contract for services or supplies would jeopardize public

15 safety.

17 **Section 2.** This act shall apply to procurement of

18 supplies and services on or after July 1, 2019.

20 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2019.
