Educational attainment executive council.

## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to government; continuing the educational
- 2 attainment executive council; providing duties; providing for
- 3 staffing; requiring reports; providing appropriations; and
- 4 providing for an effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 Section 1.

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- 10 (a) The purpose of this act is to continue the work of
- 11 the educational attainment executive council, created by
- 12 executive order 2018-4. The educational attainment executive
- 13 council is continued and shall consist of the following

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14 fifteen (15) members:

1 (i) The president of the University of Wyoming, 2 who shall serve as a council co-chairman; 3 4 (ii) A president of a Wyoming community college as selected by the community colleges' presidents council, who 5 shall serve as a council co-chairman; 6 7 8 (iii) The executive director of the Wyoming community college commission; 9 10 11 (iv) The superintendent of public instruction or 12 her designee; 13 14 (v) Two (2) members of the executive council of 15 economically needed diversity options for Wyoming (ENDOW) as 16 selected by the governor; 17 18 (vi) A school district superintendent as selected 19 by the governor;

(vii) A representative of the governor's office as selected by the governor;

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1 (viii) The director of the department of workforce 2 services; 3 4 (ix) A representative of the University of Wyoming whose responsibilities concern enrollment services 5 and 6 student success as selected by the governor; 7 8 (x) The chief executive officer of the Wyoming business council; 9 10 11 (xi) An individual with expertise in the delivery 12 of education to individuals on the Wind River Indian Reservation as selected by the governor; 13 14 15 (xii) An employee of the Wyoming community college 16 commission with experience on a college completion initiative 17 as selected by the Wyoming community college commission; 18 19 (xiii) One (1) member of the Wyoming senate as 20 selected by the president of the senate; and 21 (xiv) One (1) member of the Wyoming house of 22 23 representatives as selected by the speaker of the house.

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2 (b) A majority of members of the council shall

3 constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business of

4 the council.

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6 (c) The educational attainment executive council shall:

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8 (i) Establish a five (5) year strategic plan and

9 a ten (10) year strategic plan to meet the needs of Wyoming's

10 businesses and to reach the following educational attainment

11 goals:

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13 (A) By 2025, sixty-seven percent (67%) of

14 Wyoming's working population, age twenty-five (25) to

15 sixty-four (64), will possess a valuable postsecondary

16 certificate or degree;

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18 (B) By 2040, eighty-two percent (82%) of

19 Wyoming's working population, age twenty-five (25) to

20 sixty-four (64), will possess a valuable postsecondary

21 certificate or degree.

1 (ii) Convene stakeholders to develop the strategic 2 plans; 3 4 (iii) Convene meetings with stakeholders and the public across Wyoming to obtain necessary information and 5 suggestions on strategic plan elements; 6 7 8 Include analysis of opportunities (iv) an 9 coordinated across priority economic sectors as identified by the executive council of ENDOW; 10 11 12 (v) Establish appropriate data metrics performance indicators in the development of the strategic 13 plans and communicate relevant data to the governor, state 14 15 legislators and the public; and 16 17 (vi) Develop legislative recommendations present to the joint education interim committee or the joint 18 19 minerals, business and economic development interim committee 20 to effectuate the strategic plans as necessary. 21 The educational attainment executive council shall 22 23 be staffed by the Wyoming community college commission. The

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1 University of Wyoming, the seven (7) Wyoming community

2 colleges, the department of education and the department of

3 workforce services shall provide assistance to the

4 educational attainment executive council as the council shall

5 direct. The legislative service office shall provide such

6 assistance with drafting legislative proposals as the

7 legislative members of the council shall direct.

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(e) The educational attainment executive council shall 9 10 report quarterly on its progress to develop strategic plans 11 to the governor, the board of trustees of the University of 12 Wyoming, the Wyoming community college commission and the executive council of ENDOW. The educational attainment 13 executive council, by September 1 of each year, shall report 14 to the joint education interim committee and the joint 15 16 minerals, business and economic development interim committee 17 on its progress to develop strategic plans. The council shall also, by September 1 of each year, present any proposed 18 19 education related legislation to effectuate the strategic 20 plans to the joint education interim committee and any 21 proposed economic development related legislation effectuate the strategic plans to the joint minerals, 22

business and economic development interim committee.

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The council shall continue until December 31, 2022, 2 (f) 3 at which point its existence shall cease. Members of the 4 council who are legislators shall be paid salary, per diem and mileage as provided in W.S. 28-5-101 for their official 5 duties as members of the council. Subject to constitutional 6 limitations, members of the council who are employees or 7 8 elected officials of the state of Wyoming shall be considered on official business of their agency or office and shall 9 10 receive mileage and per diem in the manner provided by their 11 agency or office. Any other member of the council shall be 12 paid no salary but shall receive mileage and per diem at the 13 same rate as state employees as provided by W.S. 9-3-102.

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## 15 Section 2.

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17 (a) There is appropriated seventy-five thousand dollars
18 (\$75,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative service
19 office. This appropriation shall only be expended for
20 providing payments authorized by section 1 of this act to
21 legislative members of the education attainment executive
22 council.

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1 (b) There is appropriated forty thousand dollars

2 (\$40,000.00) from the general fund to the governor's office.

3 This appropriation shall only be expended for providing

4 payments authorized by section 1 of this act for any member

5 of the educational attainment executive council appointed by

6 the governor who is not an employee or elected official of

7 the state of Wyoming.

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9 (c) Funds appropriated under this section shall be for

10 the period beginning with the effective date of this act and

11 ending December 31, 2022. Notwithstanding any other provision

12 of law, funds appropriated under this section shall not be

13 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any

14 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this

15 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

16 2022.

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18 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as

20 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
