15 **22-3-119. Wyoming voter identification card.**  
16

17 (a) Any person holding or retaining an expired or unexpired  
18 Wyoming driver's license primarily for purposes of voter  
19 identification, may apply to surrender or invalidate that license  
20 and receive a Wyoming voter identification card issued as provided  
21 in this section as a valid alternative form of identification.  
22

23 (b) Each county clerk shall provide at least one (1) place  
24 in the county at which the clerk shall accept applications for and  
25 issue Wyoming voter identification cards in accordance with this  
26 section. Wyoming voter identification cards issued under this  
27 section shall only be valid for purposes of acceptable  
28 identification under W.S. 22-3-118 and shall only be available to  
29 persons who meet all of the following qualifications:  
30

31 (i) The person is a registered elector of the state;  
32

33 (ii) The person has a valid expired or unexpired  
34 driver's license issued under title 31 of the Wyoming statutes;  
35

36 (iii) The person desires to surrender or otherwise  
37 invalidate their Wyoming driver's license in order to receive a  
38 Wyoming voter identification card.  
39

40 (c) A person shall apply in person for a Wyoming voter  
41 identification card. An application for a Wyoming voter  
42 identification card shall:  
43

1 (i) Require the following information from the  
2 applicant:

3  
4 (A) Full legal name;

5  
6 (B) Current residence address;

7  
8 (C) Date of birth;

9  
10 (D) A physical description of the applicant  
11 including sex, height, weight and eye color.

12  
13 (ii) Be signed and sworn to by the applicant under  
14 penalty of perjury.

15  
16 (d) Prior to issuing a Wyoming voter identification card to  
17 a person, a county clerk shall:

18  
19 (i) Verify that the person has a valid expired or  
20 unexpired Wyoming driver's license;

21  
22 (ii) Verify that the person is registered to vote in  
23 the state;

24  
25 (iii) Require documentation showing the person's name  
26 and address of principal residence;

27  
28 (iv) Require the person to surrender their Wyoming  
29 driver's license to the county clerk or otherwise allow the county  
30 clerk to invalidate the license.

31  
32 (e) No fee shall be charged or collected for the application  
33 for or issuance of a Wyoming voter identification card. The  
34 Wyoming voter identification card shall be captioned "WYOMING  
35 VOTER IDENTIFICATION CARD" and shall contain a prominent statement  
36 that under Wyoming law it is valid only as identification for  
37 voting purposes. The Wyoming voter identification card shall be  
38 laminated, contain a digital color photograph of the applicant and  
39 include all of the following information:

40  
41 (i) The information required by paragraph (c)(i) of  
42 this section;

43  
44 (ii) The date the voter identification card was issued;

45  
46 (iii) The county where the voter identification card  
47 was issued;

1  
2 (iv) Any other information or identification as  
3 required by rule of the secretary of state.  
4

5 (f) A Wyoming voter identification card shall remain valid  
6 so long as the person resides in the same county and remains  
7 qualified to vote. A person who moves residence outside of the  
8 county in which a Wyoming voter identification card was issued may  
9 surrender his card to the county clerk of the county of his new  
10 residence within the state and may after the surrender apply for  
11 and receive a new card if the person is otherwise eligible under  
12 this section. Any person who moves residence outside the state or  
13 who ceases to be qualified to vote shall surrender his Wyoming  
14 voter identification card to the county clerk who issued the card.  
15

16 (g) The secretary of state shall provide each county clerk  
17 with the necessary equipment, forms, supplies and training for the  
18 production of the Wyoming voter identification cards and shall  
19 maintain the equipment.  
20

21 (h) The department of transportation, in consultation with  
22 the secretary of state, shall develop a process for county clerks  
23 to verify and take possession of or otherwise invalidate an  
24 applicant's Wyoming driver's license in accordance with this  
25 section."

8 (d) Voters who are unable to provide the required proof under  
9 the applicable provisions of ~~subsections (b) and (c) of~~ this  
10 section shall be offered provisional ballots in accordance with  
11 W.S. 22-15-105 and permitted until the close of business on the  
12 day following the election to present documentation to the county  
13 clerk establishing their eligibility to vote in the precinct.

15 (f) As used in this section:

16  
17 (i) "Acceptable identification" includes a Wyoming  
18 voter identification card issued under W.S. 22-3-119;  
19

20 (ii) "Wyoming federal election" means a primary  
21 election, general election or a special election for federal office  
22 held in this state."

32 (a) The secretary of state shall promulgate rules as  
33 required by this act.

37 22-3-119(h), as created by this act.

41 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section,  
42 this act is effective July 1, 2020.  
43

44 (b) Sections 4 and 5 of this act are effective immediately  
45 upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as  
46 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution."
