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1	(iii) Issue <u>, or </u> refuse to issue <u>or suspend the:</u>
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3	(A) Authority to operate as a contract or
4	private motor carrier; <u>or</u>
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6	(B) Commercial vehicle registration.

11	(k) Upon application and payment of fees as prescribed
12	by subsection (d) of this section, the department shall
13	register commercial vehicles and in the case of Wyoming based
14	commercial carriers issue distinctive Wyoming license plates.
15	In the case of non-Wyoming based commercial vehicles the
16	department may issue distinctive Wyoming license plates,
17	distinctive stickers, or other suitable visual identification
18	devices in such form as prescribed by the department which
19	shall be affixed to the vehicle as required by the department.
20	The department may also issue a registration card for each
21	vehicle registered identifying the vehicle which shall be
22	carried in the vehicle at all times. <u>The department shall</u>
23	cancel, revoke, suspend or refuse to issue the registrations

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1	provided by this section based upon a finding from its records
2	and prior experience that:
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4	(i) The operation or equipment used renders the
5	highways unsafe;
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7	(ii) Delinquent fees are due and payable to the
8	department; or
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10	(iii) The permittee has not complied with or
11	continues to not comply with all laws and applicable rules
12	and regulations of this act or governing the operations of
13	interstate motor carriers as defined by law.
14	
15	(y) A temporary permit issued under this section shall
16	be carried in the power unit. Unlawful use of the temporary
17	permit or fraudulent or false information given to obtain the
18	temporary permit invalidates the permit and results in the
19	penalty provided by W.S. 31-18-701. The department shall
20	cancel, revoke, <u>suspend</u> or refuse to issue the temporary
21	permits provided by this section based upon a finding from
22	its records and prior experience or from the records and prior
23	experience of the department that:

Issuance of authority; matters to be 3 considered; deposit of insurance. 4 5 (a) The department shall issue authority to qualified motor carriers. The authority shall remain valid and in effect 6 unless revoked or suspended by the department for good cause, 7 8 such as a violation of this act, or cancelled at the request 9 of the authority holder. 10 11 31-18-301.
