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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-1-117 and 36-6-101(b) are amended
- 11 to read:

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1	36-1-117. Sale or trade of state lands; hearing upon
2	request of county commissioners; notice of proposed sale or
3	trade.
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5	(a) No sale or trade of any state land including
6	state land currently held by the state of Wyoming shall be
7	made without a public hearing in the county in which the
8	land is located if a hearing is requested by the county
9	commissioners.
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11	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section,
12	the board or the director as established by rule of the
13	board shall provide notice of any proposed sale or trade of
14	state lands to each subsurface owner or mineral lessee not
15	less than sixty (60) days before the sale or trade. As used
16	in this subsection:
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18	(i) "Subsurface owner" means any private person
19	holding any recorded legal or equitable interest in the
20	title to the mineral rights underlying a land surface as
21	filed of record with the county clerk of the county in
22	which the land is located;

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1 (ii) "Mineral lessee" means any private person entitled under any type of mineral lease to extract or 2 3 otherwise remove the minerals on state lands under the 4 jurisdiction of the board. 5 6 leases; extensions; 36-6-101. Terms of rules regulations; notice; rent and royalties; assignment of 7 8 leases; grazing and agricultural leases; cooperation with United States or its lessees, in cooperative or unit plans. 9 10 The board is further authorized to make and 11 (b) 12 establish rules and regulations governing the issuance of 13 oil and gas, coal and other mineral leases and covering the conduct of development and mining operations. The rules and 14 regulations shall require the board or director to provide 15 16 notice of any proposed lease sale or renewal thereof to each surface owner, subsurface owner or mineral lessee not 17 less than sixty (60) days before the sale or renewal. As 18 19 used in this subsection: 20 21 (i) "Surface owner" means any private person holding any recorded legal or equitable interest in the 22 title to the land surface on which the minerals will be 23

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1	leased, as filed of record with the county clerk of the

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4	(ii) "Subsurface owner" means any private person
5	holding any recorded legal or equitable interest in the
6	title to the mineral rights underlying a land surface as
7	filed of record with the county clerk of the county in

11	entitled under any type of mineral lease to extract or
12	otherwise remove the minerals on state lands under the
13	jurisdiction of the board.
