1 AN ACT relating to health care; requiring the reporting of 2 state of Wyoming employee health care claims data as specified; providing conditions; providing a sunset date; 3 and providing for an effective date. 4 5 б Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. W.S. 9-3-220 is created to read: 8 9 10 9-3-220. Health care claims data reporting. 11 12 (a) Upon approval of the governor and in consultation with the department of insurance and the department of 13 health, the department of administration and information 14

15 shall submit health care claims data from the state

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1 employees' and officials' group insurance plan to a 2 multi-payer health care claims database that includes data 3 from Wyoming employers if the governor finds: 4 (i) That the costs of submitting the data to the 5 claims database are reasonable in light of the likely 6 benefits of submitting the data to the claims database for 7 8 Wyoming employers, the state of Wyoming and the Wyoming public; 9 10 11 (ii) That, without disclosing personally identifiable information, the database makes sufficient 12 information available to the public to allow the database 13 to serve a substantial public benefit; 14 15 16 (iii) That submission of the data to the 17 database will be beneficial to Wyoming's employers and residents; 18 19 20 (iv) That, pursuant to a written agreement, data submitted to the database will be used, disclosed and 21 stored in compliance with all relevant state and federal 22

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laws and that no personally identifiable information will
be publicly disclosed;

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4 (v) That other relevant factors weighing against 5 the submission of data to the claims database do not 6 substantially outweigh the benefits of submitting the data. 7

8 (b) All data submitted to a multi-payer health care 9 claims database pursuant to subsection (a) of this section 10 shall be submitted, stored and disclosed in compliance with 11 state and federal laws regarding disclosure of all 12 confidential health care data and no personally identifiable information shall be publicly disclosed. 13

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15 (c) The department of health may provide in-kind 16 services for data collection and analysis in lieu of the 17 state paying part or all of any monetary charges to any 18 claims database under subsection (a) of this section.

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20 (d) Data submitted to a multi-payer health care 21 claims database pursuant to subsection (a) of this section 22 shall be considered a public asset, shall not become the 23 property of any person other than the state of Wyoming and,

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1 subject only to confidentiality or other limitations imposed by state or federal law, may be used to review and 2 3 improve operation of the state employees' and officials' 4 group insurance plan. 5 (e) This section is repealed on July 1, 2025. б 7 8 Section **2**. W.S. 9-3-205(a) by creating a new 9 paragraph (xvii) is amended to read: 10 9-3-205. Administration 11 and management of group 12 insurance program; powers and duties; adoption of rules and 13 regulations; interfund borrowing authority. 14 (a) The department shall administer and manage the 15 16 state employees' and officials' group insurance program 17 and, subject to the provisions of this act: 18 19 (xvii) Submit any information required by W.S. 20 9-3-220 to a multi-payer health care claims database. 21
