2 (A) For dealers selling fewer than twelve 3 (12) vehicles in any twelve (12) consecutive month period, 4 a permanent commercial building located within the state of Wyoming at which the business of a new motor vehicle dealer 5 may be lawfully carried on in accordance with the terms of 6 all applicable building codes, zoning and other land-use 7 8 regulatory ordinances, and in which building the public may contact the vehicle dealer or his vehicle salesman at all 9 10 reasonable times, and at which place of business shall be kept and maintained the books, records and files necessary 11 to conduct the business. The business shall be sufficiently 12 13 identified with an exterior sign permanently affixed to the building or land with letters clearly visible from the 14 15 highway facing the site and designated to indicate the 16 nature of the business and the landline telephone number of the business. A landline dedicated telephone number shall 17 be required in <u>for</u> the principal place of business; 18

(B) For dealers selling twelve (12) or more
vehicles in any twelve (12) consecutive month period, a
site upon which a permanent building is located containing
adequate facilities to carry on the business of a licensed

1 dealer and used to conduct business as a dealer and not 2 primarily used as, or attached directly to, a residence, 3 with space thereon or contiguous thereto adequate to permit 4 the display of at least five (5) vehicles and sufficiently 5 identified with an exterior sign permanently affixed to the building or land with letters clearly visible from the 6 highway facing the site and designated to indicate the 7 8 nature of the business. The facilities, sign and space for 9 display shall be in compliance with all applicable zoning 10 ordinances prescribed by the municipality or county in 11 which they are located and in which building the public may 12 contact the vehicle dealer or the dealer's salespersons during the declared business hours, and at which place of 13 business shall be kept and maintained the books, records 14 15 and files as required by W.S. 31-11-107(a) and (b) necessary to conduct the business. A landline dedicated 16 17 telephone <u>number</u> shall be required <u>in for</u> the principal place of business with a published phone number listed to 18 19 in the principal place of business;
