- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-420 by creating a new subsection
- 10 (d) is amended to read:

7-13-420. Good time allowances.

14 (d) The rules established under subsection (a) of

15 this section shall:

16

1	(i) Provide that good time may be awarded for
2	time the sentencing court awards as jail credit in the
3	judgment and sentence if the inmate or parolee would have
4	otherwise received good time credit if the inmate or
5	parolee had served that time in an institution eligible
6	under subsection (a) of this section;
7	
8	(ii) Provide that good time may be awarded for
9	any time an inmate or parolee spends in custody from the
10	date of sentencing until admission to an institution
11	eligible under subsection (a) of this section;
12	
13	(iii) Require the department to consult with the
14	county sheriff to determine whether good time should be
15	awarded to an inmate or parolee before awarding good time
16	for jail credit under this subsection.

18	Section 2.
19	
20	(a) The provisions of this act shall apply to all
21	persons who, on or after the effective date of this act,
22	are:

23

1	(i) Sentenced for any crime and are awaiting
2	transfer to a facility listed in W.S. 7-13-420(a);
3	
4	(ii) Serving a sentence; or
5	
6	(iii) On parole.
7	
8	Section 3. The governor, in consultation with the
9	board of parole and the department of corrections, shall
10	promulgate any rules necessary to implement this act by
11	July 1, 2020.
12	
13	Section 4.
14	
15	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
16	section, this act is effective July 1, 2020.
17	
18	(b) Sections 3 and 4 of this act are effective
19	immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
20	bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
21	the Wyoming Constitution.
