1 AN ACT relating to highways and bridges; designating a bridge as specified; providing for signage; providing an 2 3 appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: б 7 **Section 1**. W.S. 24-1-138 is created to read: 8 9 24-1-138. Dr. Leonard L. Robinson World War II Bataan 10 Death March memorial bridge. 11 The bridge on United States Interstate Highway 25 crossing 12 13 over Center Street in Casper, Wyoming shall be known as the "Dr. Leonard L. Robinson World War II Bataan Death March 14

Memorial Bridge." The department of transportation shall
install appropriate signage, in compliance with applicable
federal and state law, to identify the Dr. Leonard L.
Robinson World War II Bataan Death March Memorial Bridge.

6 Section 2. Nothing in this act shall require the 7 department of transportation to remove or modify any 8 designation of the bridge specified in section 1 of this 9 act submitted to the federal highway administration.

11 Section 3. There is appropriated five thousand 12 dollars (\$5,000.00) from the general fund to the department 13 of transportation for purposes of installing signage required by this act. This appropriation shall be for the 14 period beginning with the effective date of this act and 15 16 ending June 30, 2022. This appropriation shall not be 17 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining 18 from this 19 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 20 2022. It is the intent of the legislature that this 21 appropriation not be included in the department of 22 transportation's standard budget for the immediately 23 succeeding fiscal biennium.
