for

1 AN ACT relating to chancery courts; amending provisions 2 related to the chancery court of the state of Wyoming; clarifying disposition of fees; clarifying the jurisdiction 3 of the chancery court as specified; making technical 4 5 corrections; making conforming amendments; and providing 6 for an effective date. 7 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 9 10 Section 1. W.S. 5-13-102(a), 5-13-109(a)(ii) and 11 (iii) and 5-13-115(b)(vii), (xiii), (xiv), by creating a 12 new paragraph (xvi), (c) and (d) are amended to read: 13 14 5-13-102. Chancery court fund account created;

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15 purposes.

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2 (a) There is created an account entitled "the 3 chancery court account."- The chancery court account shall 4 receive all filing fees received by the chancery court. Any interest accruing to the account shall be retained in the 5 account and may be expended for the purposes provided in 6 this section. No funds shall be expended from the account 7 until the legislature appropriates the funds. Funds within 8 9 the account shall be used for the purpose of funding 10 operation of the chancery courts, including judicial 11 salaries, staff salaries, supplies, operating costs and 12 other expenses of the chancery court.

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14 5-13-109. Temporary assignment to fill vacancies;
15 appointments to fill vacancies in office.

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(a) Prior to the appointment of a chancery court judge under subsection (b) of this section or in the event a chancery court judge appointed under W.S. 5-13-107 dies, becomes unable or unwilling to perform the duties of his office, the supreme court may temporarily assign the duties of chancery court judge to be performed by a person who

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meets the qualifications set forth in W.S. 5-13-108. Any 1 2 assignment shall be made to: 3 4 (ii) A retired district court justice judge; or 5 (iii) A member of a panel of up to five (5) б active district court judges selected by the supreme court 7 8 to serve as <u>a</u> chancery court judge on <u>an</u> ad hoc basis. 9 10 5-13-115. Purpose and jurisdiction. 11 12 The chancery court shall have jurisdiction to (b) hear and decide actions for equitable or declaratory relief 13 and for actions where the prayer for money recovery is an 14 15 amount exceeding fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), 16 exclusive of claims for punitive or exemplary damages, prejudgment or post judgment interest, costs and attorney 17 fees provided the cause of action arises from at least one 18 (1) of the following: 19 20 21 (vii) Shareholder derivative actions. The 22 monetary threshold set forth in this subsection (b) of this

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section shall not apply to action actions brought under 1 2 this paragraph; 3 (xiii) Dissolution of corporations, 4 partnerships, limited liability companies, limited 5 liability partnerships, joint ventures, banks and trust 6 companies. The monetary threshold of set forth in this 7 8 subsection (b) of this section shall not apply to action 9 actions brought under this paragraph; 10 11 (xiv) Transactions governed by the Wyoming 12 Uniform Trust Code; -or 13 (xvi) A dispute concerning a trademark, trade 14 name or service mark. The monetary threshold set forth in 15 this subsection shall not apply to actions brought under 16 this paragraph. 17 18 (c) The chancery court shall have no may exercise 19 20 supplemental ancillary jurisdiction over any cause of action not listed in subsection (b) of this section at the 21 discretion of the chancery court. 22 23
