1 (a) A governmental entity and its public employees 2 while acting within the scope of duties are granted 3 immunity from liability for any tort except as provided by 4 W.S. 1-39-105 through 1-39-112. Any immunity in actions based on a contract entered into by a governmental entity 5 is waived except to the extent provided by the contract if 6 the contract was within the powers granted to the entity 7 and was properly executed and except as provided in W.S. 8 1-39-120(b) and 24-2-101(e). The claims procedures of W.S. 9 10 1-39-113 apply to contractual claims against governmental 11 entities.

(e) The commission shall maintain offices at the state capital. The commission is empowered to sue in the name of the "Transportation Commission of Wyoming", and may be sued by that name in the courts of this state and in no other jurisdiction upon any contract executed by it. <u>Neither the commission nor the department shall assert</u>
