Air ambulance-Medicaid coverage amendments.

## A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to Medicaid; requiring the state employees' 1 2 and officials' group insurance plan to offer air ambulance services under the air ambulance transport services program 3 4 only upon federal approval of the program; requiring state 5 agency reimbursement for air ambulance services provided 6 under the air ambulance transport services program only 7 upon federal approval of the program; making the operation of air ambulance provisions in Medicaid statutes contingent 8 9 upon federal approval of the air ambulance transport 10 services program; making the payment of premium taxes for 11 the air ambulance transport services program contingent upon federal approval of the program; making workers' 12 compensation coverage for air ambulance services under 13 14 Medicaid contingent upon federal approval of the

- 2 effective date.

4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 6 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-219(a) and (b) and 42-4-123(b) as
- 7 created by 2019 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 189, Section
- 8 2 are amended to read:

- 10 9-3-219. Air ambulance transport services for
- 11 employees, officials and dependents; reimbursement; sunset.

- 13 (a) Emergency and medically necessary air ambulance
- 14 transport services for employees, officials and their
- 15 dependents shall be covered under W.S. 42-4-123, subject to
- 16 availability and any limitations specified by the
- 17 department of health under W.S. 42-4-123(a) and subject to
- 18 operation of the air ambulance transport services program
- 19 under W.S. 42-4-123(b).

- 21 (b) Contingent on operation of the air ambulance
- 22 <u>transport services program under W.S. 42-4-123(b)</u>, the
- 23 department of administration and information shall pay

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- 1 reimbursement for services under this section to the
- 2 department of health, as specified under W.S. 42-4-123.

- 4 42-4-123. Air ambulance transport services for
- 5 Wyoming residents; sunset.

- 7 (b) Contingent on federal approval under subsection
- 8 (a) of this section, there is created the air ambulance
- 9 transport services program under the department. Operation
- 10 of the air ambulance services program as provided in
- 11 subsections (c) through (p) of this section shall be
- 12 contingent on the federal approval required by subsection
- 13 (a) of this section.

- 15 **Section 2.** W.S. 26-4-102(b)(iii), 26-4-103(n) and
- 16 27-14-401(j) as amended by 2019 Wyoming Session Laws,
- 17 Chapter 189, Section 3 are amended to read:

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- 19 **26-4-102.** Record of receipts; payment to treasurer;
- 20 credit to fund.

- 22 (b) The commissioner shall promptly deposit all
- 23 monies he receives from any charges to the general fund,

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- 1 with receipt and acknowledgement submitted to the state
- 2 treasurer, except that:

- 4 (iii) <u>Any premium assessments collected under</u>
- 5 W.S. 26-4-103(n), which shall be transferred to the air
- 6 ambulance coverage account not more than thirty (30) days
- 7 after receipt.

- 9 26-4-103. Premium taxes; generally; preemption by
- 10 state.

- 12 (n) At the same time a report under subsection (a) of
- 13 this section is filed, an insurer making private health
- 14 benefit plans available in this state, and any plan which
- 15 has entered into agreement under W.S. 42-4-123(j), shall
- 16 pay to the commissioner a three-quarter percent (.75%)
- 17 assessment upon net premiums and net considerations. The
- 18 commissioner shall, not more than thirty (30) days after
- 19 receipt, transfer premium assessments paid under this
- 20 subsection to the air ambulance coverage account.
- 21 Application of this subsection shall be contingent on
- 22 operation of the air ambulance transport services program
- 23 <u>under W.S. 42-4-123(b).</u>

2 27-14-401. Medical, hospital and ambulance expenses;

3 review of claim; employer and division designated

4 providers; contracts for bill review, case management and

5 related programs; air ambulance reimbursement.

7 (j) Emergency and medically necessary air ambulance

8 transport services for an employee shall be covered under

9 W.S. 42-4-123, subject to availability and any limitations

10 specified by the department under W.S. 42-4-123(a). The

11 department of workforce services shall pay reimbursement

12 for services under this section to the department of health

13 as specified under W.S. 42-4-123. Application of this

14 subsection shall be contingent on operation of the air

15 ambulance transport services program under W.S.

16 42-4-123(b).

17

18 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon

19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

21 Constitution.
