9	authorized in writing by the person legally taking wildlife
LO	and, where the taking occurred on private land, by the
L1	landowner or manager of the land where the taking occurred.
L2	Personally identifiable and geographic information under
L3	this subsection shall be specified by rule of the
L4	commission and shall include a person's name, address,
L5	telephone number, date of birth, electronic mail address
L6	and information specifying the geographic location of the
