Wage transparency.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to labor and employment; specifying
2 employer actions which constitute an unfair employment
3 practice; prohibiting an employer from barring an employee
4 from disclosing wage information; prohibiting an employer
5 from requiring an employee to waive wage disclosure rights;
6 prohibiting an employer from discriminating against an
7 employee as specified; and providing for an effective date.

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9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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11 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-9-105(a) by creating a new
12 paragraph (v) is amended to read:

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14 **27-9-105. Discriminatory and unfair employment**
15 **practices enumerated; limitations.**

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2 (a) It is a discriminatory or unfair employment
3 practice:

5 (v) For an employer to:

6

7 (A) Prohibit an employee from disclosing
8 the employee's own wages, discussing the wages of others,
9 inquiring about another employee's wages or aiding or
10 encouraging any other employee to exercise the employee's
11 rights under this paragraph. Nothing in this subparagraph
12 shall be construed to create an obligation to disclose
13 wages;

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15 (B) Require as a condition of employment
16 nondisclosure of the employee's own wages or require the
17 employee to sign a waiver or other document that denies the
18 employee the right to disclose the employee's own wage
19 information;

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21 (C) Discharge, discipline or in any manner
22 discriminate or retaliate against an employee by altering
23 the terms, location or conditions of employment for

1 disclosing the employee's own wages, discussing the wages
2 of other employees, inquiring about another employee's
3 wages or aiding or encouraging any other employee to
4 exercise the employee's rights under this paragraph.

5

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2020.
