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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 **Section** 1. W.S. 39-11-102.1(c)(intro) and

11 39-13-102(c)(iv) are amended to read:

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39-11-102.1. Administration; state board of

14 equalization.

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1 (c) The state board of equalization shall perform the 2 duties specified in article 15, section 10 of the Wyoming 3 constitution and shall hear appeals from county boards of 4 equalization and review final decisions of the department 5 application of any interested person upon adversely affected, including boards of county commissioners for the 6 purposes of this subsection, under the contested case 7 8 procedures of the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act. Upon request of a county board of equalization providing 9 10 compelling reasons to do so, the state board 11 equalization may accept a case certified directly to the 12 state board of equalization pursuant to rules adopted by 13 the state board of equalization. The state board of equalization shall accept a case certified directly to the 14 state board of equalization that involves property that may 15 16 subject a county to tax liability as provided in W.S. 17 39-13-102(c)(iv). The board shall also review 18 decisions of the department of transportation concerning 19 the assessment or application of taxes authorized under 20 this title upon application of any interested person 21 adversely affected. Any interested person adversely affected by the adoption, amendment or repeal of a rule 22 pursuant to W.S. 16-3-103(a) 23 shall be afforded

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- 6 (c) The board of county commissioners of each county
 7 constitutes the county board of equalization. The county
- 8 board shall meet at the office of the county commissioners
- 9 at such times as necessary to perform its statutory duties,
- 10 but no earlier than the fourth Tuesday in April to consider
- 11 current year assessments. The county clerk shall act as
- 12 clerk of the county board. The county assessor or his
- 13 designee shall attend all meetings to explain or defend the
- 14 assessments. The county board of equalization shall:

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- 16 (iv) Hear and determine the complaint of any
- 17 person relative to any property assessment or value as
- 18 returned by the county assessor subject to W.S.
- 19 39-13-109(b)(i). The county board of equalization may
- 20 request that a case be certified directly to the state
- 21 board of equalization as provided in W.S. 39-11-102.1(c).
- 22 If the case involves property that may subject the county
- 23 to tax liability, the county board of equalization shall

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certify the case directly to the state board of
equalization and the county assessor and board of county
commissioners shall each have standing to appeal any
decision made by the state board of equalization regarding
the property;
