A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION to amend the Wyoming Constitution by
- 2 limiting appropriations made in a general appropriations bill
- 3 introduced during a general session in an odd numbered year
- 4 to only emergency appropriations and by making conforming
- 5 amendments.

- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
- 8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
- 9 separately, concurring therein:

- 11 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 12 Constitution, Article 3, Sections 6, 7(a) and 34 is proposed
- 13 for submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
- 14 next general election for approval or rejection to become

- 1 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority
- 2 of the electors at the election:

3

- 4 Article 3, Section 6. Compensation of members; duration
- 5 of sessions.

6

- 7 The legislature shall not meet for more than sixty (60)
- 8 legislative working days excluding Sundays during the term
- 9 for which members of the house of representatives are elected,
- 10 except when called into special session. The legislature
- 11 shall determine by statute the number of days not to exceed
- 12 sixty (60) legislative working days to be devoted to general
- 13 and budget session, respectively. The legislature shall meet
- 14 on odd-numbered years for a general and budget session. The
- 15 legislature may meet on even-numbered years for budget
- 16 session. During the budget session no bills except the budget
- 17 bill may be introduced unless placed on call by a two-thirds
- 18 vote of either house. The legislature shall meet for no more
- 19 than forty (40) legislative working days excluding Sundays in
- 20 any (1) calendar year, except when called into special
- 21 session. The compensation of the members of the legislature
- 22 shall be as provided by law; but no legislature shall fix its

2 Article 3, Section 7. Time and place of sessions.

3

4 (a) The legislature shall meet at the seat of government at twelve o'clock noon, on the second Tuesday of January of 5 6 the odd-numbered years for general and budget session and may meet on the second Tuesday of January of the even-numbered 7 years for budget session, and at other times when convened by 8 9 the governor or upon call of the legislature as herein 10 provided. The governor by proclamation may also, in times of 11 war or grave emergency by law defined, temporarily convene 12 the legislature at a place or places other than the seat of 13 government. The legislature may convene a special session not 14 to last longer than twenty (20) working days as follows:

Article 3, Section 34. General appropriation bills;

other appropriations.

19 <u>(a)</u> The general appropriation bills shall embrace 20 nothing but appropriations for the ordinary expenses of the 21 legislative, executive and judicial departments of the state, 22 interest on the public debt, and for public schools. All

- 1 other appropriations shall be made by separate bills, each
- 2 embracing but one subject.

- 4 (b) A general appropriations bill introduced during a
- 5 general session in an odd-numbered year shall embrace nothing
- 6 but appropriations for the ordinary expenses of the
- 7 <u>legislative</u>, executive and judicial departments of the state,
- 8 interest on the public debt, and for public schools, the need
- 9 for which the governor has declared as necessary for the
- 10 <u>immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or</u>
- 11 welfare.

- 13 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
- 14 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

15

- 16 The adoption of this amendment would limit general
- 17 appropriations bills introduced by the legislature in a
- 18 session during an odd-numbered year (currently referred to as
- 19 a "general session") to only those appropriations for which
- 20 the governor has declared an emergency need and which are
- 21 otherwise permissible to include in a general appropriations
- 22 bill. The proposed amendment further amends language to label

1 sessions occurring during an odd-numbered year as "general

2 sessions."
