**Catch Title:** **Driver's licenses and IDs.**  
**Subject:** Authorizing digital driver's licenses, identification cards and notifications.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The act authorizes the use of digital driver's licenses and identification cards and establishes related fees. The act specifies that a digital driver's license is supplemental to a physical driver's license and is optional to purchase.
- The act defines "display" and "surrender" in the context of a digital license or identification card, specifying that a digital license or card holder shall not have to relinquish possession of the portable electronic device on which the license or card is stored when the license or card is displayed or surrendered. Additionally, display of a digital license or card shall not serve as consent to search the person's portable electronic device.
- The act does not require a person, other than the Department of Transportation if the department chooses to issue digital driver's licenses or identification cards, to accept digital licenses or cards or to purchase equipment to verify the accuracy of digital licenses or cards.
- The act clarifies that an individual may possess only one (1) state issued, federal law compliant digital driver's license or identification card at a time.
- The act also authorizes electronic notices relating to license expirations and renewals when a person has consented to receive notices electronically.
