Catch Title: **Human trafficking-penalty for subsequent conviction.**

Subject: Increasing penalties for subsequent convictions of human trafficking.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The act provides that, for second or subsequent convictions of first-degree and second-degree human trafficking, the penalty is not less than twenty-five (25) years' imprisonment up to and including life imprisonment without parole.
- The enhanced penalty applies if the victim is a minor; the defendant has one (1) or more previous convictions for first-degree or second-degree human trafficking and the defendant is convicted for the offenses after turning eighteen (18) years old.
