**Catch Title:** **Good time allowances for jail time.**

**Subject:** Authorizing the award of good time credits for jail time.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- Current law authorizes the Governor to adopt rules to establish a system of good time allowances for inmates and parolees. Good time allowances deduct time from an inmate's or parolee's sentence.
- The act provides a system for awarding good time allowances to inmates and parolees for the time they spend in jail before admission to a state correctional institution.
- The act applies to sentences of record for persons that are active on or after July 1, 2020 and who have been sentenced, are serving a sentence, or are on parole.
- The act requires the Governor to promulgate rules, in consultation with the Board of Parole and the Department of Corrections, necessary to implement this good time system.

**Comments:**

- This act has a split effective date. The rulemaking authority is effective immediately, and the remaining provisions are effective on July 1, 2020.
