**Catch Title:** **Contract brewing.**  
**Subject:** Contract arrangements for brewers to brew for others.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The act defines contract brewing and specifies the requirements for a permit for contract brewing. The definition states in part that "contract brewing" means a commercial arrangement in which a client brewer or microbrewer contracts with a brewery or microbrewery to produce malt beverage for the client brewer or microbrewer and where the contract brewery or microbrewery is responsible for specified packaging, reporting, labeling, certification, approvals, distribution and tax requirements.
- The act provides that a local licensing authority may allow a permit for a client brewer or microbrewer to sell its malt beverages obtained through a contract brewing arrangement for on-premises or for off-premises consumption.
