Catch Title: **Budget modifications-executive.**

Subject: Notice requirements for "B-11" authority.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Existing law authorizes the Governor to revise, change, redistribute, or increase amounts authorized for expenditure by legislative appropriation acts from nongeneral fund sources under certain circumstances through the "B-11" process. The authority may be exercised after the Governor notifies the Legislature that new funds will address an emergency, conserve general funds, are needed to address revised program requirements, or unanticipated nongeneral fund revenues have become available.
- The act revises the "B-11" process to require ten (10) days' notice to be provided to the Legislature prior to exercise of authority for funds exceeding one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for federal funds and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for other nongeneral funds.
