Catch Title: **Dr. Leonard L. Robinson memorial bridge.**
Subject: Designating a bridge in Casper, Wyoming as the Dr. Leonard L. Robinson, World War II Bataan Death March Memorial Bridge.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The bill designates the bridge on Interstate 25, crossing Center Street in Casper, as the Dr. Leonard L. Robinson World War II Bataan Death March Memorial Bridge. Dr. Robinson was a Casper Wyoming resident who survived the Bataan death march and three and one-half (3.5) years as a prisoner of war in a forced labor camp.
- The bill requires the Department of Transportation to install appropriate signage identifying the bridge as designated.

Comments:

- The bill appropriates five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to the Department of Transportation for signage.
