Catch Title: **Chancery court amendments.**

Subject: Wyoming Chancery Court.

Summary/Major Elements:

- In 2019, the Legislature passed a bill that created the Wyoming Chancery Court.
- The act clarifies various provisions related to temporary assignments to the chancery court, the chancery court's account and the chancery court's jurisdiction.
- The act provides that actions regarding trademarks, trade names and service marks fall within the chancery court's jurisdiction.
- The act also authorizes the chancery court to exercise supplemental ancillary jurisdiction over other causes of action ancillary to those causes of action within the chancery court's jurisdiction.
