Catch Title: **Importation of prescription drugs-study.**
Subject: Requiring a study of the feasibility of importing prescription drugs.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The act requires the Department of Health to study the feasibility of establishing a prescription drug importation program in Wyoming.
- Among other things, the Department must study the potential savings of importing, the drugs with the best potential for importation that will lead to savings, the process for obtaining federal certification to import drugs, any impacts of an importation program and any administrative costs associated with operating a program.
- The act requires the Department of Health to report on the results of the study by October 1, 2020 and to recommend whether it is feasible to implement a prescription drug importation program in Wyoming.
- The act provides that further legislative authorization is needed before a state agency seeks federal approval or seeks to implement an importation program.

Comments:

- The act requires the Department of Health to report to the Joint Labor, Health and Social Services Interim Committee by October 1, 2020 on the results of the study.
