Catch Title: **CHIP-state administration.**
Subject: Child Health Insurance Program.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The Child Health Insurance Program is designed to provide health, vision and dental insurance to minors through the age of eighteen (18) who are otherwise uninsured and meet certain income and eligibility guidelines.
- The act allows the Wyoming Department of Health to either continue using private insurance to manage the Child Health Insurance Program or run the Program itself if it can provide the same services for a lower cost.
- The act requires the Department to competitively procure all contracts for Program operation at least once every five (5) years.
- The act limits the amount a medical provider is paid for services provided under the Child Health Insurance Program to an amount set by the department or an amount negotiated with any private health insurance company used to operate the Program.
