Catch Title: **Animal shares.**
Subject: Selling shares of animals for meat distribution.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The act extends the Food Freedom Act (W.S. 11-49-101 through 11-49-104), which Act allows for a producer's production and sale of homemade food and drink products for home consumption and encourages the expansion of agricultural sales.
- The act defines an animal share to be a right that entitles the owner to a share of an animal or herd and provides a right to receive a corresponding share of meat from the animal or herd. The act imposes several conditions on how a share is created and specific contract provisions the share must contain.
- The act establishes how meat subject to an animal share must be delivered, including labeling and disclosure requirements.
