**Subject:** Personal and geographic information related to legal takings.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The bill excludes personally identifiable and geographic information related to the legal taking of wildlife from disclosure under the Public Records Act.
- The bill requires the Game and Fish Commission to not publicly release personally identifiable information about a person legally taking wildlife unless the person authorizes the release in writing.
- The bill requires the Game and Fish Commission to not publicly release geographic information about a legal taking on private land without the written authorization of the person legally taking the wildlife and the owner or manager of the land.
- The bill requires the Game and Fish Department to promulgate rules to implement this act.
