Catch Title: **Transportation of nonresident students.**

Subject: Nonresident student transportation.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, a school district may send school buses into another school district for the purpose of loading or discharging students residing in that district. The act prohibits that practice, but creates the following three (3) exceptions to the prohibition:
 - If the transportation is performed for shared services for the purpose of efficiency;
 - If the transportation is required for the educational stability of a child taken into protective custody; or
 - If the two (2) school districts agree to the student's attendance in the school district in which the student does not reside.
