**Catch Title:** **Health insurance costs-bundled payment study.**

**Subject:** Controlling health insurance costs.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The act requires the Department of Administration and Information (A&I) to study and make recommendations for bundled payments to health care providers under the State Employees' and Officials' Group Health Insurance Plan ("Plan").
- Making bundled payments means making one (1) payment to cover a course of treatment for a particular disease or health problem, rather than making individual payments for each treatment or service provided to a patient.
- Under the bill, A&I must study the potential benefits and cost savings associated with making bundled payments to health care providers who provide services that are reimbursed by the Plan.
- The bill requires A&I to report its findings to the Joint Labor, Health and Social Services Interim Committee by August 31, 2021.
