Catch Title: **Hemp production-fees.**

Subject: Fees for hemp and hemp production regulation.

Summary/Major Elements:

- In 2019, Wyoming enacted legislation authorizing hemp production and hemp processing under state law. The law required the Wyoming Department of Agriculture to submit a state plan to the federal United States Secretary of Agriculture for primary regulatory authority of hemp in Wyoming. In 2020, the plan was approved.
- The act:
 - Requires the Wyoming Department of Agriculture to require verification for effective disposal of hemp products that contain Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) in excess of allowable amounts and authorizes fees for the verification;
 - Authorizes the Wyoming Department of Agriculture to impose fees for inspections and chemical sampling and analysis of hemp production or processing activities;
 - Requires rulemaking.
