Catch Title: **Special event liquor licenses.**

Subject: Requiring the issuance of special-event liquor licenses for rodeos.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The act requires local licensing authorities to issue special malt beverage permits for events conducted on the grounds of a rodeo with a total seating capacity of more than seven thousand five hundred (7,500) after application and upon submission of a reasonable sales and control plan by the applicant.
- The act sets requirements for serving malt beverages under the special permit and a maximum fee, which is not more than two times the maximum fee for 24-hour permits.
- The act allows local licensing authorities to set graduated fees and prohibits licensing authorities from assessing additional fees for the issuance of the special malt beverage permit. The licensing authority can still negotiate with the applicant for paying costs incurred during the event and for recouping costs that the licensing authority is entitled to under law.
