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7	Section 1. W.S. 9-1-402 by creating a new subsection
8	(d), 9-3-408(a), 9-3-710, 15-5-422(a) and 35-9-617(b) are
9	amended to read:
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11	9-1-402. State auditor; duties generally.

13	(d) The state auditor may approve an alternative to
14	the use of warrants drawn by the state auditor for the
15	disbursement of retirement system benefits, provided that

1 <u>the attorney general reviews the legality of the</u> 2 <u>alternative.</u>

9-3-408. Designated custodian of retirement account;
disbursements; investment of account monies.

7 (a) The board may designate the state treasurer or a master custodial bank approved by the state treasurer as 8 the custodian of the retirement account. Disbursements from 9 10 the retirement account for purposes specified in W.S. 9-3-407(c) shall be made only upon warrants drawn by the 11 12 state auditor upon certification by authorized system 13 employees or using an appropriate alternative method approved by the state auditor. All retirement account 14 15 disbursements shall be accounted for in accordance with the 16 uniform state accounting system or in a manner approved by 17 the state auditor or the state treasurer as provided under W.S. 9-4-214. As used in this subsection, "authorized 18 19 system employees" means the director and his designees who 20 have authorized signatures on file with the state auditor. 21

9-3-710. Disposition of funds; custodian of monies.

Funds accruing to the account used to fund benefits for the 1 2 program under this act shall be commingled with all money 3 deposit with the state treasurer in the Wyoming on 4 retirement account. The board may designate the state treasurer as the custodian of the retirement account. 5 Disbursements from the account for purposes as specified in 6 W.S. 9-3-407(c) shall be made only upon warrants drawn by 7 the state auditor upon certification by authorized system 8 employees or using an appropriate alternative method 9 10 approved by the state auditor. All disbursements from the 11 account shall be accounted for in accordance with the 12 uniform state accounting system or in a manner approved by 13 the state auditor or the state treasurer as provided under W.S. 9-4-214. As used in this section, "authorized system 14 employees" means the director and his designees who have 15 16 authorized signatures on file with the state auditor, 17 "director" means the director of the Wyoming retirement system, and "system" means the Wyoming retirement system. 18

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20 15-5-422. Payments; when and how made; protections;
 21 nonassignability; qualified domestic relations order.

1 (a) Payments made under this article shall be made to 2 the beneficiaries on or before the fifth day of each month. 3 and Payments shall be made by voucher drawn against the 4 firemen's pension account and paid by the state auditor out of the account or using an appropriate alternative method 5 6 approved by the state auditor. No payments made under this article are subject to judgment, attachment, execution, 7 garnishment or other legal process and are not assignable 8 9 nor shall the board recognize any assignment nor pay over 10 any sum assigned.

Disbursements from the account shall be made 21 only upon warrants drawn by the state auditor upon 22 certification by authorized system employees <u>or using an</u>
