- 1 AN ACT relating to the funding of government operations;
- 2 creating the transportation information system account;
- 3 requiring reporting; and providing for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1**. W.S. 31-1-204 is created to read:

8

9 31-1-204. Transportation information system account.

- 11 (a) There is created the transportation information
- 12 system account into which shall be deposited funds as
- 13 provided by law. Earnings from funds in the account shall
- 14 be credited to the account. Funds in the account are
- 15 continuously appropriated to the department of
- 16 transportation and shall only be expended to replace the

- 1 revenue information system that was in use on July 1, 2020.
- 2 Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008 or 9-4-207, unexpended funds
- 3 in the account shall not revert without further action of
- 4 the legislature.

- 6 (b) The department of transportation may accept, and
- 7 shall deposit in the transportation information system
- 8 account, any gifts, contributions, donations, grants or
- 9 federal funds designated for computer system modernization.

11 Section 2.

- 13 (a) Not later than July 1, 2027, the department of
- 14 transportation shall replace the revenue information
- 15 computer system in use by the department on July 1, 2020.
- 16 The department shall use funds from any appropriate source
- 17 to fund the replacement of the computer system under this
- 18 section. The department of transportation shall apply for
- 19 any federal funds available or that may become available.

- 21 (b) The department of transportation shall determine
- 22 by rule and regulation fees for third party use of the
- 23 replacement revenue information computer system. At least

- 1 fifty percent (50%) of any fee implemented for use of the
- 2 computer system shall be deposited in the transportation
- 3 information system account created by W.S. 31-1-204.

- 5 (c) The department shall develop and implement the
- 6 replacement revenue information system in accordance with
- 7 the provisions of section 4 of this act.

- 11 (a) The department of transportation Wyoming
- 12 information system (WIS) shall be purchased or developed,
- 13 configured and implemented in consultation with the
- 14 University of Wyoming computer science department
- 15 (University) and the department of enterprise technology
- 16 services (ETS). The purchase or development, configuration,
- 17 migration and full implementation of WIS (the WIS project)
- 18 shall be a jointly undertaken for the benefit of the state
- 19 of Wyoming as provided in this section.

- 21 (b) The University and ETS shall guide and advise the
- 22 department of transportation on all aspects of the WIS
- 23 project, including assistance with the issuance of a

	request for proposats. The request for proposats sharr
2	ensure that upon implementation and throughout its life,
3	WIS:

5	(i) Provides efficient information exchange
б	among diverse public and private partners;
7	
8	(ii) Complies with accepted national industry
9	standards for personal, revenue and tax information
10	exchange and storage systems, including but not limited to:
11	
12	(A) National Information Exchange Model
13	(NIEM);
14	
15	(B) Payment Card Industry standards;
16	
17	(C) National Institute of Standards and
18	Technology cyber security and other applicable standards;

21	(D) Internal Revenue Publication 4812 Audit
22	and Accountability Requirements.

1 (iii) Is hosted in the most efficient, effective 2 and economical redundant state of the art environments; 3 4 (iv) Continually evolves to incorporate innovative technology to improve operational and economic 5 efficiencies. 6 7 (c) The department of transportation, University and 8 9 ETS shall consult with public and private partners who will 10 access, share or exchange information with WIS before issuance of the request for proposals to plan for 11 12 coordination throughout the life of the project, including the office of the attorney general and other executive 13 branch agencies, the supreme court and local and federal 14 15 agencies. 16 (d) The department of transportation, in consultation 17

with the University and ETS, shall create a committee to 18 review and make recommendations to the department of 19 20 transportation on vendor and system selection. The 21 committee shall consist of no more than twelve (12) members. Members shall possess in-depth knowledge of 22

1	large-scale computer information exchange and storage
2	systems. The committee shall include:
3	
4	(i) Two (2) members selected by the director of
5	ETS, one (1) of whom shall serve as chairman;
6	
7	(ii) Two (2) members selected by the chairmen of
8	the joint transportation, highways and military affairs
9	interim committee;
10	
11	(iii) Two (2) members selected by the chairmen
12	of the joint appropriations committee;
13	
14	(iv) Two (2) members selected by the University;
15	
16	(v) Two (2) members selected by the department
17	of transportation from an entities who will exchange data
18	with WIS;
19	
20	(vi) Two (2) members selected by the department
21	of transportation.
22	

- 1 (e) The committee created under subsection (c) of
- 2 this section shall receive product demonstrations from
- 3 vendors chosen jointly by the department of transportation,
- 4 the University and ETS from vendors responding to the
- 5 request for proposals.

- 7 (f) No later than July 1, 2021, the department of
- 8 transportation, University and ETS shall provide to the
- 9 joint transportation, highways and military affairs interim
- 10 committee and to the joint appropriations committee a
- 11 proposed timeline for each phase of the WIS project. The
- 12 timeline shall anticipate a full configuration, migration,
- 13 implementation and closeout of the WIS project no later
- 14 than July 1, 2027.

15

- 16 (g) The department of transportation, University and
- 17 ETS shall provide a written and verbal joint report to the
- 18 joint transportation, highways and military affairs interim
- 19 committee and to the joint appropriations committee at
- 20 their next meetings after July 1, 2021 and each following
- 21 meeting until closeout of the WIS project. The reports

22 shall provide a brief update as to:

1	(i) Project schedule, successes and lessons
2	learned;

4	(ii) Resources acquired and needed throughout
5	each project phase, including project management,
6	department of transportation subject matter experts,
7	outside subject matter experts and consultants;
8	
9	(iii) An accounting of funds received and
LO	expended from the transportation information system
L1	account;

L3	(iv) Project budget.

L5	(h) The department of transportation, University and
L6	ETS shall develop a reimbursement schedule for consulting
L7	and other services provided by the University and ETS to
L8	the department of transportation under this act. The
L9	schedule shall be submitted to the joint transportation,
20	highways and military affairs interim committee and joint
21	appropriations committee no later than July 1, 2021.

3	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
4	section, this act is effective July 1, 2021.
5	
6	(b) Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this act shall be
7	effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary
8	for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section
9	8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
