A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to enact legislation 2 and requesting that the Veteran's Administration work to 3 expand and improve efforts to treat traumatic brain injuries 4 and post-traumatic stress disorder.

6 WHEREAS, national veteran suicide crises data indicates that 7 as many as twenty-two (22) veterans die by suicide every day; 8 and

10 WHEREAS, traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress
11 disorder can be causes of suicide; and

13 WHEREAS, data collected from 2000 to 2019 from Department of 14 Defense numbers for Active, Guard and Reserve members in the 15 Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines, indicate that for all 1

1 severities of traumatic brain injuries, a total four hundred 2 thirteen thousand eight hundred fifty-eight (413,858) service 3 members who suffer from traumatic brain injuries; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the number of veterans with post-traumatic stress б disorder varies by service era but ranges from about eleven percent (11%) to about thirty percent (30%); and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress disorder both involve physical injury to brain tissue; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, current standards of care approved for veterans for 13 traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress disorder 14 focus on medication and counseling; and 15 WHEREAS, additional treatments, vocational counseling and 16 17 rehabilitation therapies exist that have been clinically 18 proven to mitigate symptoms and improve recovery when used 19 alone or integrated with counseling. Additional therapies to treat traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress 20 21 disorder include physical therapy, occupational therapy, 22 cognitive therapy, speech therapy and hyperbaric oxygen 23 therapy; and

1 2 WHEREAS, hyperbaric oxygen therapy couples hyperbaric oxygen 3 chamber treatment, which promotes oxygen for healing and 4 restoring injured brain tissue, together with counseling; and 5 б WHEREAS, access to a variety of treatments improves a 7 veteran's opportunities for healing and recovery; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Traumatic Brain Injuries and Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Treatment Act (2019 S. 2504/H.R. 4370) will 10 require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish 11 12 hyperbaric oxygen therapy to a veteran suffering from 13 traumatic brain injury or post-traumatic stress disorder. 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE 15 16 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING: 17 18 Section 1. That the Wyoming Legislature requests that 19 Congress swiftly enact legislation providing for veterans' 20 access to treatments for traumatic brain injury and post-21 traumatic stress disorder that include hyperbaric oxygen 22 therapy, such as the Traumatic Brain Injuries and Post-23 Traumatic Stress Disorder Treatment Act and any other

legislation improving or authoring access to other important
 therapies and counseling and legislation fostering research
 and development of additional therapies.

5 Section 2. That the Wyoming Secretary of State transmit 6 copies of this resolution to the Wyoming Congressional 7 Delegation and the Secretary of the United States Department 8 of Veterans Affairs.
