## for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming 2 Constitution to allow local government entities to invest 3 in stocks and equities upon a two-thirds vote of both 4 houses of the legislature; and providing a ballot 5 statement.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting 9 separately, concurring therein:

11 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming 12 Constitution, Article 16, Section 6(a)(ii) by creating a 13 new subparagraph (C) is proposed for submission to the 14 electors of the State of Wyoming at the next general 15 election for approval or rejection to become valid as a

part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority of the 1 2 electors at the election: 3 4 Article 16, Section 6. Loan of credit; donations 5 prohibited; investment of funds; of internal works б improvement. 7 8 Neither the state nor any county, city, township, (a) town, school district, or any other political subdivision, 9 10 shall: 11 (ii) Subscribe to or become the owner of the 12 13 capital stock of any association or corporation, except 14 that: 15 16 (C) The legislature may provide by law for the investment of county, city, township, town, school 17 district, or any other political subdivision's funds in the 18 19 capital stock of any association or corporation and may 20 designate which of these funds may be invested. The 21 legislature may prescribe different investment conditions for each type and class of political subdivision and for 22 each type of fund. Any legislation establishing or 23

1 increasing the percentage of any fund that may be invested under this subparagraph shall be passed only by a two-2 3 thirds (2/3) vote of all the members of each of the two (2) 4 houses voting separately. 5 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse б 7 the following statement on the proposed amendment: 8 Currently, the Wyoming Constitution allows the legislature 9 to authorize certain state funds to be invested in the 10 11 stock of corporations and other associations. This 12 amendment will allow the legislature, by two-thirds vote of 13 the members of both houses, to authorize county, city, town, school district and other political subdivision funds 14 to be invested in the stock of corporations and other 15 16 associations. 17
