6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 2-14-101(a) and (c) is amended to
- 9 read:

- 11 2-14-101. Taking of life precludes one from
- 12 inheritance, insurance or survivorship benefits; how

13 benefits distributed; notification of insurer necessary.

1	(a) No person who feloniously takes or causes or
2	procures another to take the life of another shall:
3	
4	(i) Inherit from or take by devise or legacy
5	from the deceased person any portion of his estate:
6	
7	(ii) Inherit, receive or otherwise take any
8	property held with the deceased person in a joint tenancy
9	with rights of survivorship, tenancy by the entirety or any
10	other form of co-ownership with rights of survivorship;
11	
12	(iii) Inherit, receive or otherwise take any
13	property conveyed by the deceased person by beneficiary
14	designation, transfer on death designation, payable on
15	death designation or other conveyance that occurs because
16	of the death of the deceased person.
17	
18	(c) In every instance mentioned in this section all
19	benefits that would accrue to any such person upon the
20	death of the person whose life is taken shall become
21	subject to distribution among the other beneficiaries or
22	heirs of the deceased person according to the will, trust
23	or other valid dispositive instrument of the deceased

1	person as though the person causing the death of the
2	deceased person has predeceased the deceased person, or if
3	no such valid instrument exists, according to the rules of
4	descent and distribution. However, an insurance company is
5	discharged of all liability under a policy issued by it
6	upon payment of the proceeds in accordance with the terms
7	thereof unless before payment the company receives written
8	notice by or in behalf of some claimant other than the
9	beneficiary named in the policy that a claim to the
10	proceeds of the policy will be made by heirs of the
11	deceased under the provisions of this section.
12	
13	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
14	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
15	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
16	Constitution.
