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1 reliability of service, depreciation of and plant, 2 technological obsolescence of equipment, expense of 3 operation, physical and other values of the plant, system, 4 business and properties of the public utility whose rates are under consideration. In determining just and reasonable 5 rates for electricity the commission shall consider common 6 sets of facts developed pursuant to W.S. 37-2-114(b)(i) and 7 regional benefits provided by the utility. 8 9 10 (e) The commission may, in all matters relating to plans, proposals or applications for authority to construct 11 12 or retire major facilities having any immediate or 13 potential effect on rates charged to customers or to recover through rates any cost thereof, consider 14 reliability and cost externalities incurred by the state of 15 16 Wyoming, including but not limited to economic, employment and viewshed impacts. 17 18 19 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
