Description of appropriation:

This appropriation will fund meeting travel and per diem for non-state employees who are members of the proposed Geothermal Task Force. The funds will be administered by the Wyoming Geological Survey.

Up to two representatives and one senate member of the Joint Minerals, Business and Economic Development Interim Committee (Minerals Committee) may be appointed by the chairmen to act as legislative liaisons to the Task Force, with authority to attend task force meetings but without authority to vote. It is assumed that the funding of legislative salary and per diem for these legislative liaisons would come from the Minerals Committee budget.
