

**FISCAL NOTE**

The bill would eliminate the Wyoming Provider Recruitment Grant program (program) administered by the Department of Health (Department).

The bill would require the Department to revert all unexpended and unobligated funds remaining in the Wyoming Provider Recruitment Account to the Budget Reserve Account on April 1, 2021. The Department estimates the reversion will be \$122,000.

The source of the expenditure decrease is the elimination of the program.

**Assumptions:**

The estimated expenditure decrease in the table is due to the Department no longer needing to administer the program. The elimination of the program would result in approximately 6 healthcare facilities in underserved areas not receiving financial assistance for the recruitment of healthcare professionals from out-of-state.
