Source of revenue (decrease):

The source of the revenue decrease would be the result of the elimination of the Birth Cost Recovery Program.

Assumptions:

The Wyoming Department of Health (WDH) recovers some birth recovery costs through Medicaid, both directly from clients and through the Department of Family Services. If this bill is enacted, in future years, the WDH estimates the GENERAL FUND will forego approximately \$54,000 per fiscal year in cost recovery revenue.

The Department of Family Services estimates that approximately \$196,000 of staff time has been expended each biennium meeting the requirements of the statute. If this bill is enacted, the duties and responsibilities of the child support enforcement staff will be reallocated toward traditional child support cases.
