Source of revenue (decrease):

The source of the revenue decrease is from reduced filing fees for both misdemeanor and felony expungement applications, which are directed to the GENERAL FUND.

Assumptions:

The Judiciary states that on average over the last five years, approximately 100 expungement cases occur annually. These cases include both felony and misdemeanor cases. The revenue reduction of \$20,000 should be interpreted as the high-end estimate as it assumes all expungements would be felony applications with a reduced fee from \$300 to \$100 per application (\$200 decrease per application). The draft bill also stipulates a reduced fee for misdemeanor expungement applications from \$100 to \$50 per application (\$50 decrease per application).

Both the Judiciary and the Wyoming Attorney General's Office would not experience fiscal or personnel impacts if the bill is enacted.
