Source of revenue increase:

Allowing scratch-off tickets as a permitted lottery game;

Assumptions:

It is assumed new revenue would be received by the Wyoming Lottery Corporation sales from scratch ticket sales as authorized, which are currently prohibited. Data evaluated included comparison and evaluation of population, revenue, direct game costs, and overhead for neighboring states such as Colorado, South Dakota, and Montana since 2015. The Wyoming Lottery Corporation also evaluated other gaming offered in these states that could impact scratch ticket revenue (i.e. Video Lottery Terminals, Skills, and Pari-Mutual). Additional data used was from the Wyoming Pari-Mutuel Report and the South Dakota Annual Report for additional reference points to gaming revenue in other states.
