

**FISCAL NOTE**

Any federal funds provided to the state for COVID-19 related purposes including from the Coronavirus Relief Fund Act, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act, P.L. 116-136, or other similarly purposed federal act, that do not accrue to any agency under W.S. 9-2-1006(a) and which were not appropriated in 2021 Senate File 0118 are appropriated to the Governor's Office for the emergency expenses of government that are consistent with the terms of the federal gift, grant or appropriation.

There is appropriated all unexpended, unencumbered and unobligated funds received by the state of Wyoming to the State Auditor from the Coronavirus Relief Fund Act, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act, P.L. 116-136 or other similarly purposed federal act, including funds originally appropriated in 2020 Wyoming Special Session Laws, Chapter 1, Section 2(b), Chapter 2, Section 4(d) and Chapter 3, Sections 2(h), 3(h) and 4(g). Any unobligated, unencumbered and unexpended funds remaining from this reappropriation on June 30, 2023 shall be deposited to the General Fund unless otherwise provided by federal law. Funds appropriated in 2021 Senate File 0118 as enacted into law shall not be included in this appropriation.

Any additional fiscal or personnel impact is not determinable due to insufficient time to complete the fiscal note process.
