

FISCAL NOTE

This bill contains a re-appropriation of \$80,000,000 to the Wyoming Business Council from any federal funds appropriated in 2020 Wyoming Special Session Laws, Chapter 1, Section 2(b) for the purpose of extending funding for the Wyoming Business Interruption Stipend Program. This re-appropriation would be used for grants to agriculture businesses pursuant to the Wyoming Business Interruption Stipend Program created by 2020 Wyoming Special Session Laws, Chapter 3, Section 2(b). This re-appropriation is effective immediately.

The bill states that any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this re-appropriation on December 30, 2020 shall revert as provided by law.

In the event the December 30, 2020 reversion date is extended by the Wyoming Legislature, this bill could have an administrative impact to the Wyoming Business Council.

NOTICE-AGENCY ESTIMATE OF ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACT REQUESTED

This bill has administrative impact that appears to increase duties or responsibilities of one or more state agencies and may impact agency spending or staffing requirements. As introduced, the bill does not modify any state agency budget or current personnel authorizations.
