Except as otherwise provided by law, the public schools of 8 each school district in the state shall at all times be 9 10 equally free and accessible to all children resident 11 therein of five (5) years of age as of August 1, or 12 September 15 if pursuant to an approved request under W.S. 21-3-110(a)(xxxviii), of the year in which they may 13 register in kindergarten as provided in W.S. 21-4-302(b) 14 15 the age of twenty-one (21), subject to and under 16 regulations of the board of trustees. Each school district 17 shall operate its schools and its classes for a minimum of one hundred seventy-five (175) days each school year unless 18 19 an alternative schedule has been approved by the state 20 board. Prior to submission of a proposed alternative 21 schedule to the state board, the board of trustees shall 22 hold at least two (2) advertised public meetings within the 23 district, at which the board shall present the proposed

Any school district operating under an 3 alternative schedule shall annually evaluate the 4 effectiveness of that schedule in meeting the educational goals and purposes for which the schedule was adopted. 5 б 7 21-4-302. Age for registration in first grade and kindergarten; preschool programs. 8 9 10 (a) A pupil may register in the first grade in the public schools of this state in the year in which his sixth 11 12 birthday falls on or before August 1., or September 15 if 13 the child started kindergarten pursuant to an approved 14 request under W.S. 21-3-110(a)(xxxviii). 15 16 (b) A pupil may register in kindergarten in the public schools of this state in the year in which his fifth 17 birthday falls on or before August 1., or September 15 if 18 19 pursuant to an approved request under W.S. 20 21-3-110(a)(xxxviii). 21

It is the intent of the legislature that 15 16 this act shall be applicable to the 2021-2022 school year 17 and to each school year thereafter. 18 19 Section 4. This act is effective August 1, 2021.
