## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0101

Elk feedground closings-requirements.

## A BILL

for

1 ACT relating to elk feedgrounds; authorizing permanent closure of an elk feedground authorized or 2 3 administered by the Wyoming game and fish commission only upon an order of the governor; requiring the recommendation 4 of the commission and comment by the Wyoming livestock 5 board for the closure of an elk feedground; requiring a 6 7 public meeting; authorizing the governor to temporarily 8 close elk feedgrounds under emergency circumstances; 9 authorizing the Wyoming game and fish commission to 10 contract or lease private and state lands for relocating 11 elk feedground sites; requiring the Wyoming game and fish 12 department to develop plans for alternative elk feedground sites as specified; requiring a report; and providing for 13 14 an effective date.

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1 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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3 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-305 is created to read:

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5 23-1-305. Closure of elk feedgrounds; alternative

6 feeding sites; reporting requirement.

of the following conditions:

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8 (a) Except as authorized by subsection (b) of this 9 section, any elk feedground authorized or administered by 10 the commission as of July 1, 2021 and in accordance with 11 W.S. 23-1-302(a)(ix), may only cease operations or be 12 subject to closure by the department or commission upon an 13 order of the governor. Any closure order issued by the 14 governor shall only be valid and lawful upon satisfaction

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17 (i) The commission shall provide its
18 recommendation to the governor for the closure of the elk
19 feedground and concurrently to the Wyoming livestock board.
20 Upon receipt of the commission's recommendation, the board
21 shall provide its opinion to the governor on whether the
22 board believes the closure of the elk feedground is

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2 (ii) The commission and the Wyoming livestock 3 board shall conduct not less than one (1) public meeting in 4 a location that is reasonably calculated to foster the most 5 public participation by the people directly impacted by the proposed closure and by other vested stakeholders. The 6 public meeting shall be held after the commission and the 7 8 board have acted as required under paragraph (i) of this 9 subsection. The commission and the board shall compile the 10 comments received as a result of the public meeting and provide those comments to the governor for the governor's 11 12 consideration on whether to issue an elk feedground closure order. 13

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(b) Any elk feedground authorized or administered by
the commission may be temporarily closed by order of the
governor due to emergency circumstances for a period not to
exceed six (6) months after which the feedground shall only
remain closed in accordance with subsection (a) of this
section.

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22 (c) The commission is authorized to contract or lease 23 private lands or lands owned by the state for the purpose

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1 of relocating an elk feedground authorized or administered

2 under W.S. 23-1-302(a)(ix), which would otherwise be

3 subject to closure under this section.

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(d) For any elk feedground authorized or administered 5 under W.S. 23-1-302(a)(ix), which utilizes federal public 6 lands, the game and fish department shall report to the 7 8 joint travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural resources 9 interim committee upon the department receiving notice that 10 the federal authorization permitting the use of the federal public lands will expire in five (5) or less years. The 11 12 report required by this subsection shall include draft 13 contingency plans identifying any appropriate private lands, lands owned by the commission or lands otherwise 14 15 owned or under the authority of the state of Wyoming for 16 the purpose of supplementing or relocating the feedground 17 operation that is affected by the expiration of any federal public land authorization. The office of state lands and 18 19 investments shall cooperate with the commission 20 identifying any alternative feedground sites consistent 21 with this section.
