A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to emergency expenses of government related 2 to business relief; providing funding for grants to agriculture businesses impacted by COVID-19; providing a 3 reappropriation of federal CARES Act funds; and providing 4 5 for an effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. As used in this section, "agriculture 10 business" means a business that is engaged in farming or ranching and produces livestock, feed, produce or other 11 12 food items normally grown or raised by ranchers or farmers. 13 14 Section 2. There is reappropriated to the Wyoming

15 business council eighty million dollars (\$80,000,000.00)

1 from any federal funds appropriated in 2020 Wyoming Special 2 Session Laws, Chapter 1, Section 2(b) and as authorized and 3 made available for expenditure in Section 2(c)(ii) or (iii) 4 for the purpose of extending funding for the Wyoming 5 business interruption stipend program to be used for grants to agriculture businesses pursuant to the Wyoming business 6 interruption stipend program created by 2020 7 Wyoming 8 Special Session Laws, Chapter 3, Section 2(b). If a COVID-9 19 relief account or other similarly named account is 10 created for the deposit of COVID-19 related emergency 11 response funds, this appropriation shall be made from that 12 account. Except as provided in this section, the funds 13 reappropriated under this section shall only be expended for making the grants authorized by this act and consistent 14 15 with the terms of the federal gift, grant or appropriation 16 from which the funds originate. This reappropriation shall 17 not be transferred or expended for any other purpose except that on or before November 15, 2020, the Wyoming business 18 19 council shall estimate the total amount of funds expended, 20 obligated and necessary for the grants authorized by this 21 section. Any funds reappropriated under this section in excess of the total amount estimated by the 22 Wyoming 23 business council are hereby reappropriated after November

1 15, 2020 to the office of the governor for the purposes 2 specified in 2020 Wyoming Special Session Laws, Chapter 1. 3 Funds reappropriated to the office of the governor shall be 4 subject to any limitations imposed by 2020 Wyoming Special 5 Session Laws, Chapter 1. Any unexpended, unobligated funds 6 remaining from this reappropriation on December 30, 2020 7 shall revert as provided by law. 8

9 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 12 Constitution.
